# YTL Construction UK at work

A few examples of what we've already done and are doing right now:

#### Brabazon

North of Bristol, we are building a new town, Brabazon, transforming the former Filton Airfield – birthplace of Concorde and supersonic travel and home to more than 100 years of aviation history – into an exciting new fully integrated place to live, work and play.

A place for enjoyment and entertainment. A centre of learning and a launchpad for business. A hub for industry and invention, with a beating social heart.

Brabazon will be a centre for the arts and culture, inspiring and entertaining in equal measure. Its houses will be proper homes for thousands of people of every generation, while its green parks and shaded public squares will bind the community together.

Every aspect of the development will be at the forefront of low carbon, sustainable development.

#### A place that changes everything.





Plans are already approved for a new urban community, enterprise district, entertainment complex, parks, schools, a university quarter and commercial developments, including:

- 6,500 houses and apartments
- 55,000 sqm of purpose-built student accommodation
- 3 hotels
- 600 bed retirement village
- 270,000 sqm of offices
- 55,000 sqm of high-tech industrial
- 25,000 sqm of retail space
- 55,000 sqm university campus
- associated infrastructure, including parkland and lake.

Located near the M4/M5 motorways, the transport infrastructure includes a new dedicated railway station, Metrobus stops and extensive cycling and walking provision.





#### Bristol water recycling centre expansion

One of our largest projects, spread over the next five years, a £100 million expansion of Wessex Water's water recycling centre at Avonmouth, which serves Bristol and the surrounding area.

The scheme will allow the continued top quality treatment of an increased volume of sewage from a city population expected to increase significantly over the next 20 years.

Our construction teams are on site, preparing the ground for major new storage and treatment facilities. These will ensure the quality of treated wastewater released into the Severn Estuary continues to pose no threat to the all-important marine environment.

This is just one of several hundred projects of varying size that we will undertake over the next five years to ensure Wessex Water delivers its environmental obligations.





#### **Durleigh water treatment centre reconstruction**

Durleigh water treatment centre is located around 2km west of Bridgwater, Somerset, and is Wessex Water's second largest surface water treatment works, serving a population of 44,500. The treatment centre was extended and reconstructed in just 36 months, increasing its output to 30 Ml/d with a total investment of £50m.

Up to the minute BIM 3D modelling was used, enabling improved project and asset information and better management of associated costs, delivery timeline and risk.

As a result of the modelling, flood mitigation works were also incorporated into the project to give 1:1000-year protection, including climate change impacts. 6



#### **Protecting the Dorset coast**

Wessex Water is committed to progressively reducing storm overflow operation across its region – including investing £30 million on the south coast in Dorset. As the town of Bournemouth continues to grow, so too does the need to protect its popular beaches by increasing the capacity in its sewer system to cut the discharges.

So YTL Construction UK is providing an extra nine million litres of additional storage at its water recycling centre at Holdenhurst, by building a new 65 metre-long storm tank.

The extra storage will help reduce overflow operations to further enhance water quality, and the project also includes processes to remove nutrients to further protect rivers and coasts from excessive growths of algae that can damage ecology and wildlife.





#### **YTL Entertainment Complex**

YTL Construction is at the heart of one of the most important developments in Bristol as lead contractor for the new Bristol arena complex. Once home to the aviation icon, the supersonic Concorde, the Brabazon Hangars are a city landmark and testament to Bristol's engineering heritage. They will become a world-class live music and entertainment venue – a new cultural hub for the entire region – comprising a 19,000 seat arena, conferencing and exhibition space and an exciting, innovative, mixed-use entertainment hall.

With the hangars transformed into one of the largest arenas in the UK, the development will not only repurpose some of Bristol's most iconic buildings, it will also become the future of indoor events. Sustainability will be centre stage; we will create the most responsible and sustainable arenas in Europe and be carbon neutral from day one.

This major development will bring together YTL's international resourcing, a range of local sub-contractors and significant innovation in construction techniques.


YTL Construction UK follows this ethos, putting sustainable solutions at the heart of everything it does.

- re-purposing of an existing structure, thereby minimising additional embodied carbon
- solar power and air source heating
- rainwater harvesting
- extensive public transport via a new train station and a Metrobus line.
